**Unit Definition:** One unit is defined as the amount of protease that cleaves the FITC-labeled casein substrate to yield an amount of fluorescence equivalent to 1.0 nmol of unquenched FITC per minute at 37°C, pH 8.0

**Resuspension:** Proteinase K dissolved in water to a final concentration of 20 mg/ml

**Storage:** Store at -20°C. Aliquot the product after reconstitution to avoid repeated freezing/thawing cycles.

**Description:** A serine protease that displays the ability to digest native proteins, thereby inactivating enzymes such as DNase and RNase without recourse to a denaturation process. It retains its activity in presence of SDS and urea. It is inactivated by diisopropyl fluorophosphates (DFP) and phenyl methane sulfonyl fluoride (PMSF).
