Description:	Alpha-Synuclein (α -Synuclein) is a 14 kD (140 amino acids) acidic presynaptic protein and is a major component of Parkinson's Disease (PD) aggregates. α -Synuclein is implicated in the pathogenesis of PD and related neurodegenerative disorders. α -Synuclein also accumulates in the brains of sporadic PD patients as a major component of Lewy bodies, which are intraneuronal cytoplasmic inclusions characteristic of PD. α -Synuclein appears to associate with other proteins that aggregate and is found in beta-amyloid plaques and neuritic tangles in Alzheimer's disease ³ . rPeptide offers a wide array of synuclein products, including fragments, mutants, preformed fibrils, and labeled versions in addition to the wild-type protein. A deletion mutant of α -synuclein (amino acids 1-95), which contains the N-terminal amphipathic domain and the NAC region.
